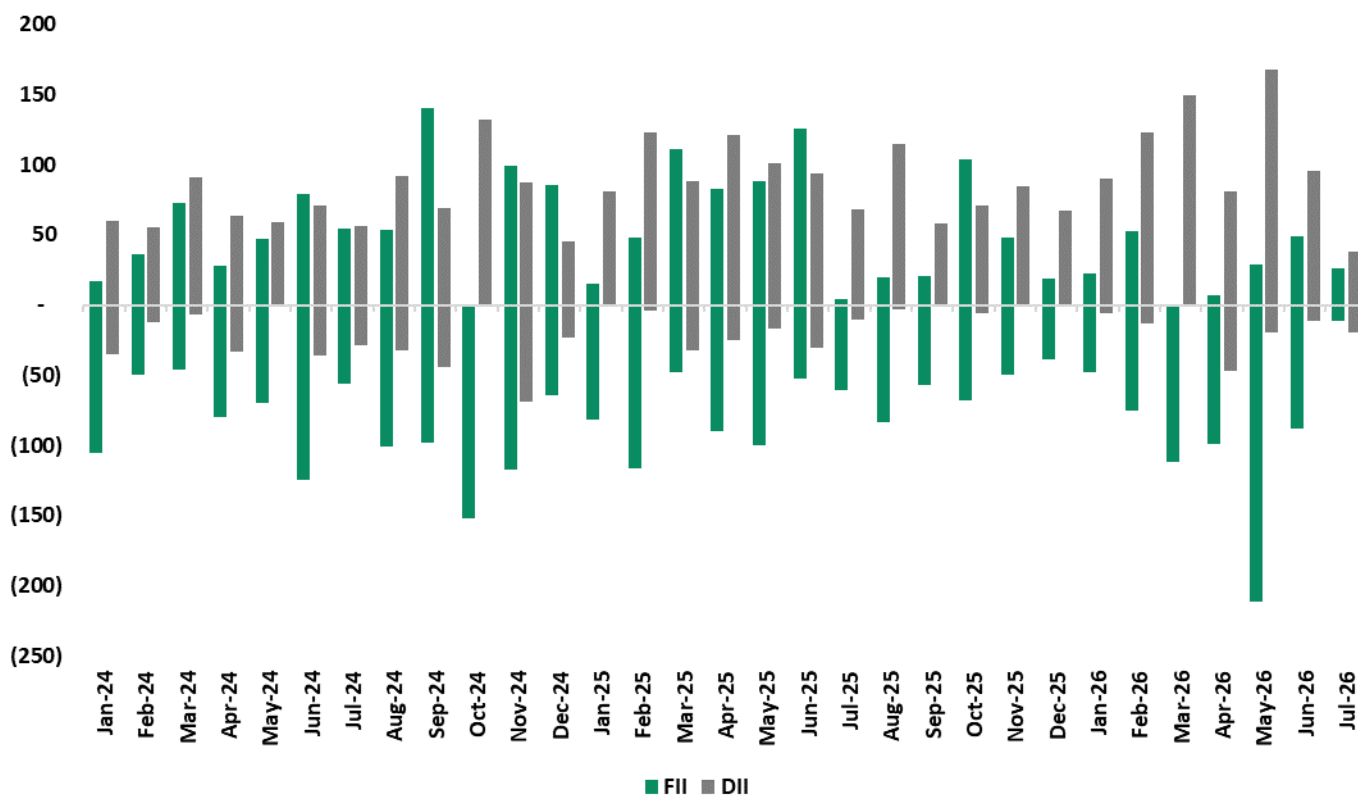
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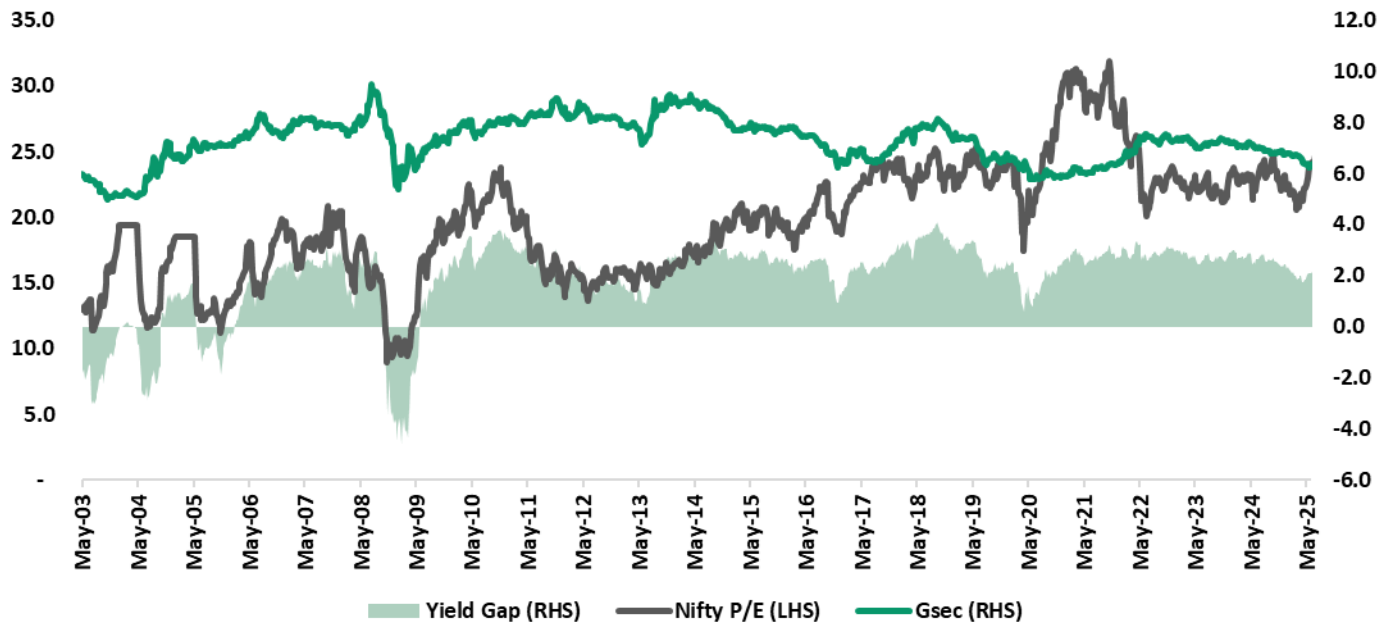

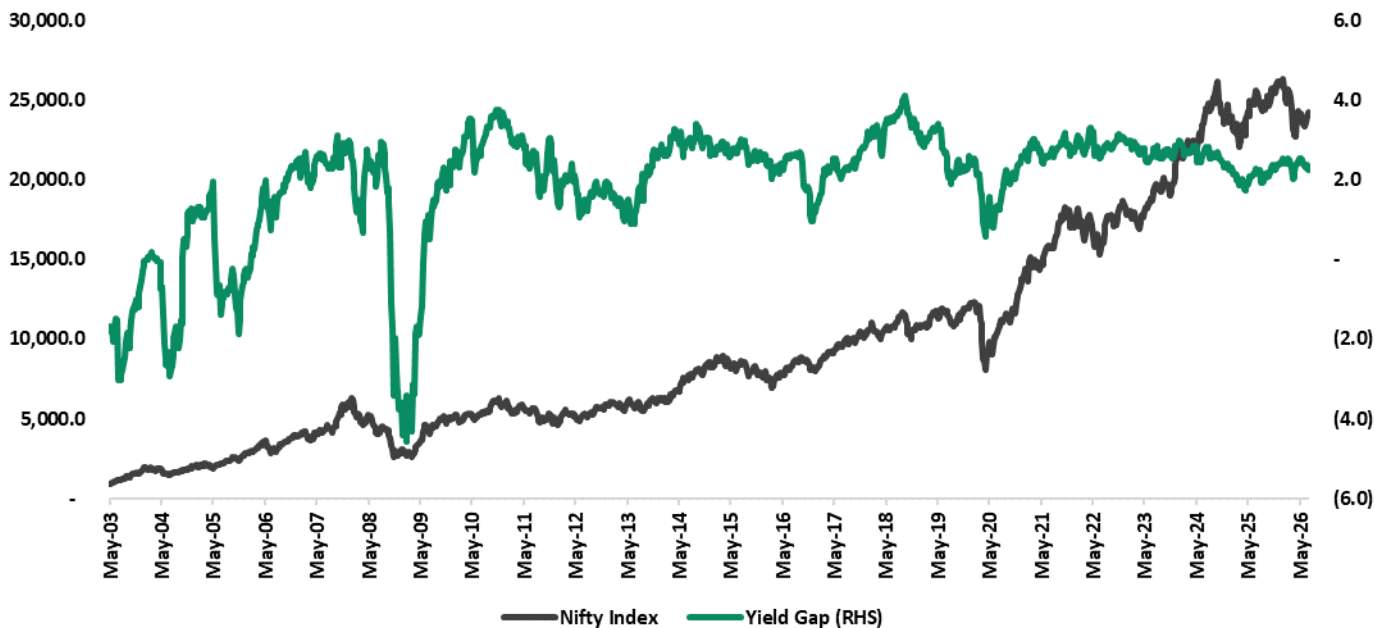

Nifty P/E - Gsec - Yield

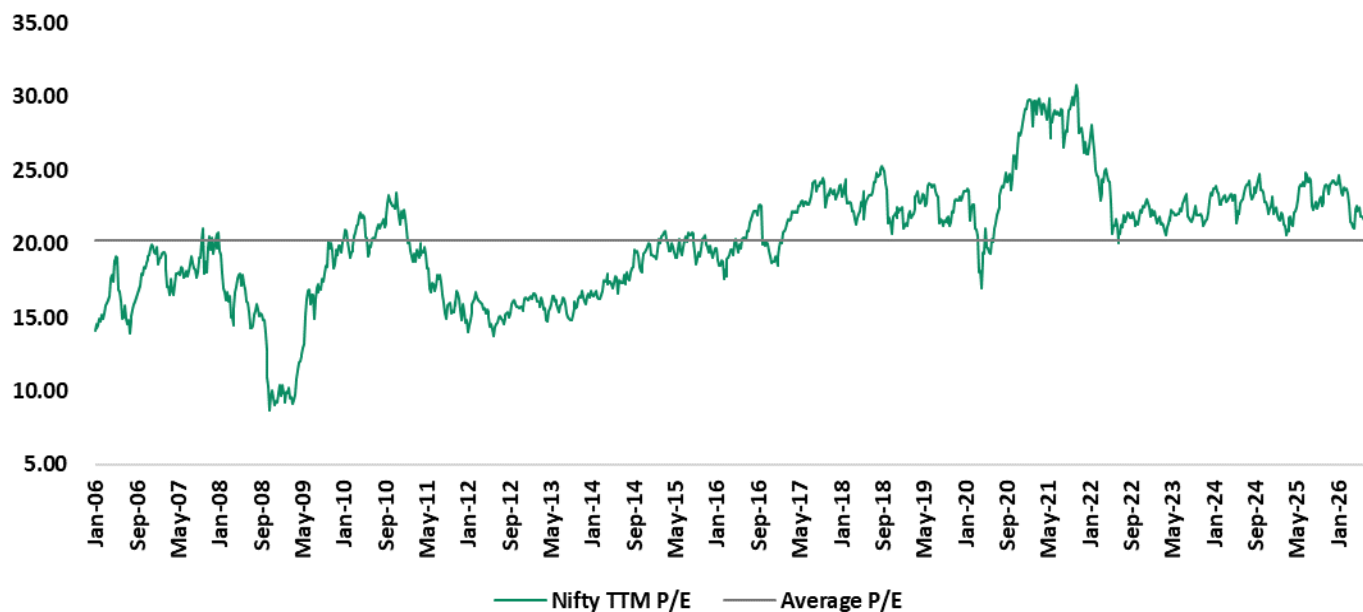


Nifty Index & Yield Gap

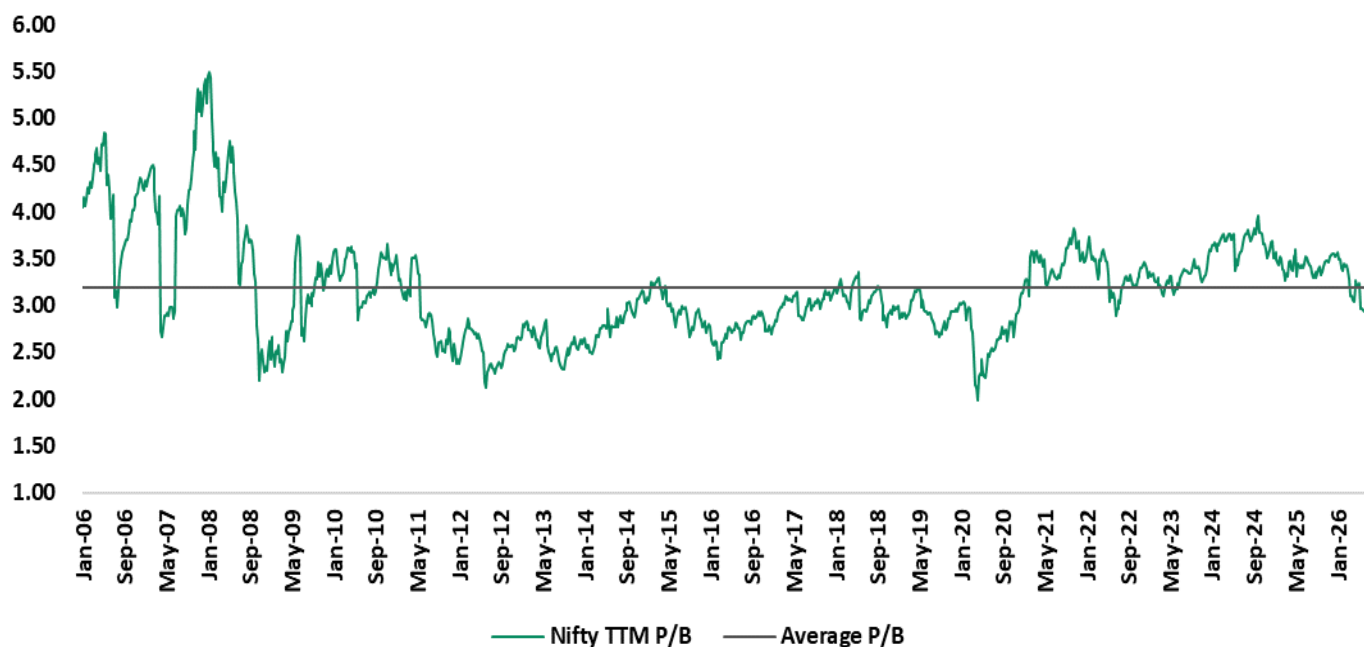

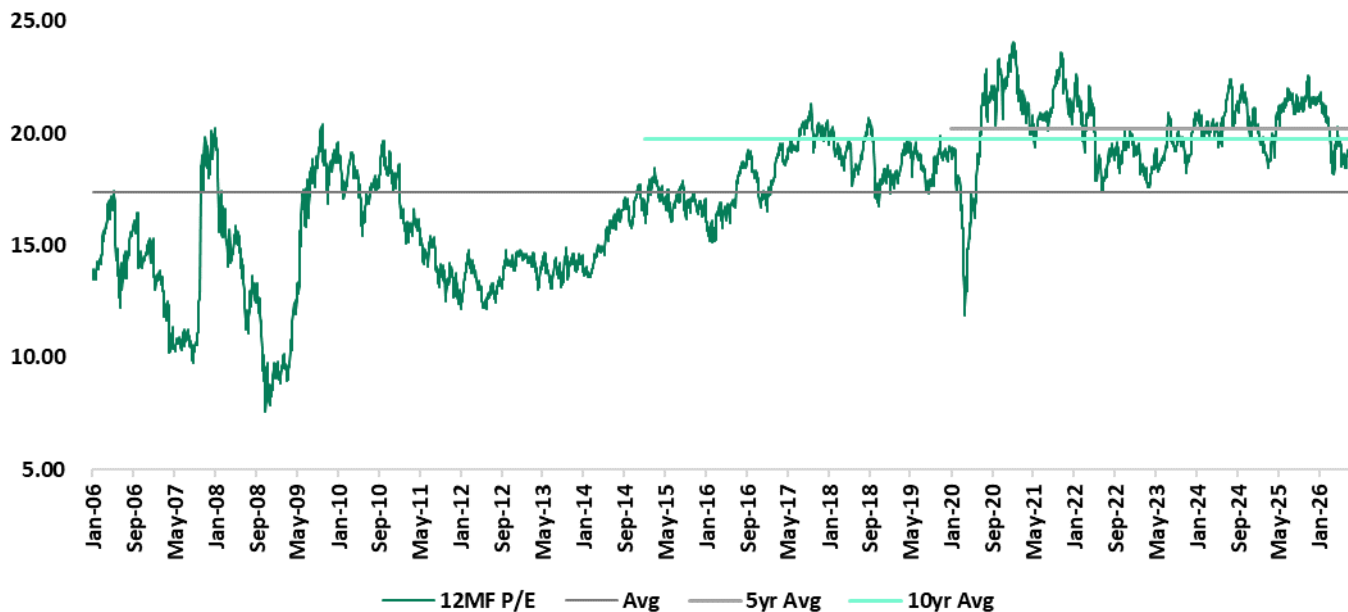
